a. Town Hall External Painting

i. Grant Funding Agreement

This document has been received from Devon County Council, and was as expected. This is to support the development of the work hub. It was

ii. Legacy Period – Devon Work Hubs Getting Building Fund

Cllr Patrinos explained the original offer included a 3 year minimum period for operating the Work Hub, this has now become 5 years due to LEP requirements. DCC have been consulted and all indication is this will have no material effect on the project or present greater risk for Council. With £100k grant coming to Lyn Valley, it was

RECOMMENDED

LTC continue with the grant and accept the 5 year minimum period for operating the Work Hub.

iii. Correspondence from a Parishioner

This was received questioning why the work hub wasn't going to have its base in the Town Hall. Councillor Patrinos had spoken to Planning Department of Exmoor National Park and it would mean a change of use for a grade 2 listed building. The Lyn Valley Society was contacted for their input as they run the book shop and raised the monies for the refurbishment of the Jubilee room, which could be the only places in the town hall that could house a work hub. They were against this idea. It would also be possible that Council could lose the funding, as this has been agreed for the original work hub building.

d. Sports/Activity Groups Possible Funding

Sport England have been in touch regarding Sports or Activity groups in Lynton & Lynmouth who may need some funding to resume activity after Covid-19. They are particularly interested in supporting any groups who provide for those who suffer from long term health conditions. It was

RECOMMENDED

Councillors will put together a list of possible groups/activities and this will be forwarded to Sport England.
